Job purpose

The primary purpose of the Supervisor role is to lead multiple work crews that are out in the community maintaining the vegetation assets of Tauranga. The Supervisor ensures efficiency, productivity and a high quality of work.

The Supervisor is responsible for:

- Planning the work crews' activities/projects.
- Resourcing the teams with the correct equipment for the tasks, ensuring Health and Safety procedures are adhered to.
- Providing sound methodological knowledge and accountable for ensuring operators are competent.
- Providing subject matter expertise on agrichemicals and related legal obligations.
- Overseeing team dynamics and team engagement.
- Team Leaders and Asset advisors regular reporting.
- Auditing (teams members, vegetation assets and maintenance routines).

The Supervisor plays a key role in creating a positive Health & Safety culture within the City Operations Team.

Key outcomes

The Supervisor provides Guide, support, and mentor the team to deliver high strong and effective quality services. leadership to their team. Proactively share your technical knowledge, helping team members problem solve to get the best results. Proactively engage with the Health & Safety Team/ Representative and City Operations leadership to maintain safe working environment. Authorise overtime and ensure timesheets are accurate Manage the recruitment, selection, onboarding and offboarding of team members. Ensure team member performance is regularly reviewed, and action is taken to address any issues. Ensure Job Start forms and SOPs are completed accurately and appropriately filed. The Supervisor is held Monitor work projects, programmes and KPI's to accountable for delivering ensure they are delivered to the appropriate outcomes that keep standard, within the required timeframe and budget. Tauranga beautiful. Triage and assign routine jobs to the team while also dealing with reactive / urgent work (CCM's) as they come in. Ensure work is completed by operators that are training and competent. Liaise with Asset Managers to ensure quality and timeliness specifications are met. Conduct H&S and quality auditing and implement corrective actions that have been identified. Engage with suppliers and sub-contractors to assist with the delivery of the work. Ensure enquires, requests and incidents are professionally responded to in accordance with TCC guidelines and recorded in TCC systems. The Supervisor is Identifying training needs in team members and action appropriate interventions. constantly evolving the team to be more efficient, Encourage team members to attend training and effective, and highly development opportunities to upskill themselves and skilled. progress along the career pathway. Actively contribute to team toolbox meetings with ideas and issues. Support team members with app usage.

- Significant experience in leading a large team of people to deliver outcomes to a high standard.

- · Effective planning and organizational skills.
- Relevant qualifications ideally: Registered Chemical Applicator Certification, Diploma in understanding herbicides, Environmental Management qualification, Level 3-4 Horticulture certificate.
- Relevant technical experience (5 years plus ideally) in revegetation/ planting, dune care, pest control, chipper use, chainsaw use, spraying and revegetation restoration.
- Class 1 / 2 licence Gross Combined Weight (GCW) of not more than 6000kg.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills with the ability to adapt your communication style to suit many different audiences.
- Advanced computer skills.
- Flexibility to work outside of normal hours and go on call for escalation or civil defense emergencies.
