The primary purpose of this role is to be responsible for the operational strategy and asset management of the City's stormwater and wastewater systems including the management of network asset maintenance work carried out by Council's contractor. In addition to manage the incorporation of developer and third party vesting of infrastructure and the implementation, renewal and upgrade of network assets, interfacing with internal and external customers and stakeholders.
